Adobe GoLive 6.0 software is the cornerstone of network publishing solutions that allow Web and cross-media professionals, from the designer to the hand coder, to create, manage and deliver personalized content for Web sites and wireless devices.

Adobe GoLive 6.0 software gives designers the tools they need to meet demanding production deadlines. New features deliver creative options and streamline the production process for Web designs that bridge the gap from print to web to wireless without complicated recoding or redesigning. The visual and dynamic authoring environment makes it easier to build media-rich and personalized Web sites that easily integrate assets created in Adobe Photoshop[®], Illustrator[®] and LiveMotion[™].

The versatile toolset streamlines your team's workflow by bringing together Web authoring, dynamic publishing, and site/file management so that designers and developers can vastly improve team collaboration and deliver web projects in less time, with less effort.

Design and Develop

Moving between multiple applications can cause unnecessary frustrations and delays. Working within the familiar Adobe interface, GoLive 6.0 helps web professionals move swiftly from concept to deployment. Unlike other authoring and site management tools, GoLive unifies information architecture, dynamic content authoring and project collaboration, resulting in the delivery of cost-effective web sites and wireless applications.

- While continuing to work within GoLive, designers can easily integrate and optimize industry-standard assets (e.g., .PSD, .AI, .SWF) with the Adobe *Smart Objects* feature.

- Designers can easily create interaction and site information diagrams using the built-in *Site Diagramming* features. Each Site Diagram can be shared amongst workgroups and easily incorporated or withdrawn from a Web project. Export capabilities to Adobe Illustrator 10 or Adobe PDF (Portable Document Format) make it simple to share diagrams for client review.

Manage

Adobe GoLive 6.0 software sheds hours off of the production process with a new site management and collaboration tool, the Adobe *Web Workgroup Server*, without the need to purchase a separate site management tool. Available only with GoLive 6.0, the Web Workgroup Server allows teams to easily track changes, share and manage files. This server-based management tool not only manages the check-in and check-out of files, but also manages resources, including site-wide link management. In addition, it provides side-by-side comparison of file versions directly in the GoLive authoring environment and the ability to rollback to previous versions of files, thus improving efficiency and eliminating common web project headaches. Browser-based administration allows for remote management and access of server-level activities, including the ability to recover sites, manage users, and control the publishing process. Additionally, any WebDAV compliant software application (e.g. Photoshop 6.0 or Illustrator 10) can be share files directly with the Workgroup server.

- In conjunction with InDesign 2.0, GoLive 6.0 delivers a real cross-media workflow for repurposing print content to the Web using XML.

- Using JavaScript, Web developers can easily extend and customize application interfaces with the GoLive Software Development Kit (SDK).

- *Master Templates* aid in production and maintenance by locking un-editable regions of a page, allowing for changes and updates only in predefined areas, which eliminates coding problems by limiting access to certain areas. As templates are updated, all template-based pages on a workgroup site are immediately updated.

Deploy

Web and cross-media professionals can broaden their reach and expand into new markets with the wireless authoring capabilities of Adobe GoLive 6.0 software. Designers can now visually design and preview content for multiple wireless devices, thereby delivering rich, personalized content to many platforms.

- Design, preview, and deploy content to multiple wireless devices using WML and i-mode standards. GoLive includes built-in emulators for Nokia and i-mode phones (emulators are only available on Windows).

- Designers can check work quickly against the latest W3C[®] code standards. Also, by taking advantage of powerful new code review features, they can reduce time spent debugging applications and maximize design time.

- Web developers can deliver database driven content with native support for common scripting languages. Dynamic Content supports ASP, PHP, and JSP, automating production work and eliminating the need for separate publishing systems for static and dynamic content by using code that works best with your environment.

- Adobe GoLive 6.0 software is the only Web authoring program utilizing streaming media technology for full QuickTime 5.0 editing. Also, it offers extended support for LiveMotion, SWF, Windows Media Player files, DHTML and SMIL 1.0.
